HEALTH & MEDICAL PROGRAMMES

COVID -19 SUPPORT PROGRAMME:

Corona virus's devastating impact includes lack of medical supplies and essentials worsening the second COVID wave hit in India. The impact of the COVID-19 has dramatically impacted people of all economic strata, in all age groups across states. This time the humanitarian crisis is unprecedented with numbers spiraling out of control with Covid reaching the villages and rural areas. With thousands coming forward to help, we at RICE, are trying our best to deliver free COVID -19 Grocery Food Support and Telemedicine Services at the doorstep for the entire quarantine period for low/no income families whose family bread-earners has been forced to stay isolated due to COVID hit and ill-health.

Grocery kits for Free RICE and TRRAIN worked together to create a food grocery delivery program for Hyderabad residents at high risk of food insecurity during the onset of the COVID-19 crisis. The program Grocery kits bag of produce and shelf stable food items to eligible individuals and families.

Our COVID program made 600 deliveries 600 unique households from 5th September to 10 th November-2021. 20 volunteers completed .20 volunteer shifts during this time packing and delivering groceries. This program was one of our largest programs to date and we could not have done it without the support of our community. Thank you to our volunteers, donors, and community partners. We are beyond grateful for your help.



FREE -COVID -19 VACCINATIONS, SANITIZER AND MASKS DISTRIBUTION PROGRAMME:

In the fight against the global pandemic, India's national vaccination programme has been one of the most successful and largest vaccination programmes when compared to many developed western nations with significantly low population base to vaccinate, it said. This organization organized COVID-19 vaccination on 22/2/2021at Gajuwaka BC Road Kakatiya IIT campus. Hyderabad: In a bid to ensure COVID-19 vaccination of the elderly, homeless people, roadside hawkers and other intellectually disabled people, a Hyderabadbased nongovernmental organization (NGO) Rural Institute of Centre for



Excellence started an initiative called 'Free covid-19 Vaccination". with the support of TRRAIN It has been 28 days since the free-of-cost initiative was launched, and over 2000 beneficiaries for the first and the second dose have been inoculated as part of this effort at t government and private vaccination centers. Due to the COVID-19, lockdown many people were afraid to come out and get vaccinated, as arranging transportation was also a



hassle. To help bridge the gap between the transportation and the vaccination, the drive was initiated. ,"Our sole purpose is to safeguard the lives of senior citizens, homeless and vulnerable people who are finding it difficult to administer the vaccine."

To make it easier for people, more than 50 mobile vaccination vans are stationed at four zones of Hyderabad, Ranga Reddy of Telangana and Vishakhapatnam, Vijayawada and Kakinada of Andhra Pradesh to take the people to the vaccination centers.

WOMENEMPOWERMENT & LIVILYHOOD ENHANCEMENT

FREE TAILORING TRAINING FOR WOMEN:

Rural mostly women's and adolescent girls of Telangana are socially and economically weaker section and dropout from the schools and colleges. This kind of rural women is mostly depending upon her husband or father for their needs. The poor and rural people included farmers dropout women's girls artisans communities forcible migrating to different places (Like, construction workers, daily wages Agriculture wages etc.).

Rural institute of Centre for Excellence has organized tailoring training programme for a period of 3 months at Kamakshipuram with the support of United way of Hyderabad. We have also distributed Stitching Machines to 33 trained women with free of cost. These trainees expressed their gratitude to **United way of Hyderabad** and **RICE** organization for this





employment training Programme. Skill development, capabilities enhancement and development of their living standard and livelihood are the important concerns which will be able to remove the poverty. Villagers will be more educated, development of the foundation education among children will be done and last but not the least if income of family will increase daily 200 rs to 300 rs additionally along with daily wages that means monthly they will earn approx Rs 6000.00 .to Rs 9000 .00 additional income , then child education will increase and child marriage, and social evils will be ended Number of women, who are living poverty line, will be reduced. By the help of giving sewing Machine training , poor village women will get better quality of life and livelihood, which will be helpful to increase the socially and economically women empowerment. As a result, the future will be bright of these 66 women and their families.

TRRAIN HER EMPOWERING WOMEN PROGRAMME:

TRRAIN Her Ascent is an initiative which began to empower women in retail. TRRAIN Her Ascent – Livelihood program aims at training and creating livelihood opportunities for women in retail. It focuses on providing employment to those who want to join the retail industry. This is a carefully designed skills training program that primarily focuses on retail skills and life skills. Through this livelihood program, TRRAIN aims to promote a gender diverse workforce in retail. TRRAIN Her is an initiative by Trust for Retailers & Retail Associates of India (TRRAIN). The initiative aims to train) and provide them with employment opportunities in retail industry creating livelihood opportunities for women in retail.



RICE and TRRAIN worked Hyderabad, together in Vizag, through TRRAIN Her Ascent - Livelihood program aims at training creating livelihood and opportunities for women in retail. It focuses providing employment to those who want to join the retail industry. Up to 2021-22 we have trained 390 beneficiaries and placed in different Retails sectors.



PANKH EMPOWERING THE PERSONS WITH DISABILITY:

PANKH - Wings of Destiny (co-founded by TRRAIN .Aims to provide PwDs employment opportunities in the retail industry through a 'Source-Train-Place' model. Accenture, a leading global professional services company, in association with TRRAIN conducted a comprehensive assessment to study the holistic economic and non-economic impact of PANKH on the PwD ecosystem—including PwD trainees, families, NGO partners, retail employers and customers. A comprehensive framework was developed and findings were gathered from several stakeholders using an appropriate mode of survey administration.
